4. Organising Dues

4.1 Organising dues will be charged on the basis of the total amount of prizes in cash and in kind convertible into cash according to the scale shown below:

4.1.1 Organising Dues for multi-discipline events

4.4 **Minimum Organising Dues**

The following minimum fees will be imposed for events without prize-money or with a prize amount lower than CHF 8'900:

5. Medication Control Fee for NFs in Groups I and II

5.1 The medication control fee will be levied on all international event in Groups I & II on the basis of the total amount of prizes in cash and in kind, by discipline, convertible into cash according to the scale shown below:

• 3.5%	on amounts up to	CHF		100′000
• 2.0%	on amounts from	CHF	100′000 to	200'000
• 1.0%	on amounts from	CHF		200'000

5.5 The FEI recommends that OCs should charge competitors CHF 12.50 per horse and per event in order to contribute towards the OCs total cost of the MCP levy based on prize-money. NF's will be invoiced by the FEI for the total amount due.

6. Registration fee for Horses/Ponies and Competitors

An annual registration fee of CHF 10 is charged for the registration of a horse, a pony or a competitor competing at CI level in all FEI disciplines

Horses:

All horses and ponies -with or without FEI Passport - must be registered.

Competitors:

The registration of competitors is mandatory for all categories, i.e. Seniors, Young Riders, Juniors, Pony riders, Children, Vaulters, Drivers and Lungers and for all levels of competition, except for those competing in the FEI Challenge and FEI Children's competition in their home country.

The registration of riders under 18 years old is free of charge.

7. Late Payment Interest

If the invoices are not paid within 90 days from the date of issue, an interest will automatically be charged at the end of each month at the rate of 10% p.a. (Bureau decision, May 2011).
