6. Registration fee for Horses/Ponies, Competitors, Trainers (Endurance)

An annual registration fee of CHF 10 is charged for the registration of a horse, a pony, a competitor or a trainer (where applicable) competing at CI level in all FEI disciplines.

The FEI has developed various apps to facilitate athletes registering in competitions and manage FEI Horses, including traceability features and monitoring of horse health at FEI Events. These developments will continue in the future and current apps will need to be maintained. Taking into account the increase of services offered to the equestrian community regarding the biosecurity for horses, particularly but not only, the IT services and the increase of costs for the FEI, the Board agreed to put forward a recommendation to the General Assembly to increase by 15 CHF the FEI Horse registration fee (currently 10.-CHF per year). This proposal to be submitted to the 2021 FEI Hybrid General Assembly to be implemented in January 2023.

Therefore, if accepted by the 2021 FEI Hybrid General assembly, the registration fees will have following structure as of 01 January 2023:

Registration for Horses/Ponies – New amount	CHF	25
Registration for Competitors/Trainers (endurance) (unchanged)	CHF	10

Horses:

All horses and ponies - with or without FEI Passport - must be registered.

Competitors:

The registration of competitors is mandatory for all categories, i.e. Seniors, Young Riders, Juniors, Pony riders, Children, Vaulters, Drivers and Lungers and for all levels of competition, except for those competing in the FEI Challenge and FEI Children's competition in their home country.

The registration of riders under 18 years old is free of charge.

7. Late Payment Interest

If the invoices are not paid within 90 days from the date of issue, an interest will automatically be charged at the end of each month at the rate of 10% p.a. (Bureau decision, May 2011).
