GEAL RULES – 2014/15

1. All Eventing SA and SAEF rules apply.
2. Grassroots horse and rider combinations from Gauteng and other provinces are eligible to accumulate points by competing at the listed participating shows throughout the season. If either **horse or rider** have **placed** at any CNC or CIC1* in the last year OR competed in any CNC or CIC2* in the last two years OR ever competed in any CNC or CIC3* they will not be eligible to accumulate points.

3. Points will be awarded at each event for first to twelfth places:

1st – 12 points	4th – 9 points	7th – 6 points	10th – 3 points
2nd – 11 points	5th – 8 points	8th – 5 points	11 th – 2 points
3rd – 10 points	6th – 7 points	9th – 4 points	12 th – 1 point

All qualifying and completed rounds – 1 point

4. There will be no back dating of points – rider combinations will appear on the Leader Board from the date they register with the League.
5. Riders may enter the league on more than one horse. Points will be awarded to horse and rider combinations and are not transferable. Each combination must remain the same throughout the season although a change of rider is acceptable in certain cases, for instance because of injury, but not where the rider is substituted to gain points. If a rider combination has accumulated sufficient points for two different levels (i.e. EV70 and EV80) in one season, the rider can decide which level to enter for the final.
6. In the event of a tie in final scores at the Championship event, the horse and rider closest to the ideal time in the cross country phase in the championship event will prevail.
7. Adult horse and rider combinations need to conclude at least three (3) season events at participating venues (listed below), as well as the Championship event at a venue to be decided in May/June 2015.
8. Junior and Pony Riders need to conclude at least two (2) season events as well as the Championship event. SANESA shows do not count towards GEAL.
9. If a rider and horse combination changes levels during the season, rounds participated in at the previous level may be counted towards qualifying for the Championship but they will only carry over the minimum points. I.e. If an Adult rider has completed two EV70 and one EV80, he or she may participate in the EV70 or EV80 championship. Please note however, any scores from levels other than the one chosen for the final will be counted as a completed round – i.e. no matter where the horse and rider combination placed you will receive 1 point for that round.
10. Participation in the Championship show is compulsory to place in the League. Riders can take the best three scores from any season shows to the final event. The winners in each category will be those with the highest accumulative score over four events including the amateur championship.
11. While scoring will be managed and overseen by the committee, it is the rider's responsibility to register for the league, to inform the league committee of their participation in shows and to ensure their results are accurately captured on the league table.
