GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations and National Rules for Eventing (1 June 2010).
- 2. **Dress** please refer to the Eventing dress regulations.
- 3. Entries
 - a) **Restriction** entries may be restricted to a practical maximum number at the sole discretion of the organising committee.
 - b) **Membership** Classes 7 11 Must be registered with ESA.
 - c) **Qualification** Competitors must ensure that all relative qualification details are correct as per detail requested above.,
 - All incorrect entries will be rejected.
 - d) Closing date of entries: All Classes: entries close at 23h00 on Monday 10th November 2014.

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED!

- g) Entry Fees include the Eventing Levy appropriate to the standard as per ESA 70 R11.40, 80 R11.40, 90 R142.50, 100 R171.00, 1* R285.00, 2* R570.00 EDTS R4.50, Gauteng Eventing levy R20.00, Medics R74.10, Admin Levy R40, Ground Levy R100
- 4. **Stabling** Available at Kyalami Equestrian Park 087 353 3328 or shows@kyalamipark.com at R175-00 per night
 - a. Please book online and add amount to your entry fee
- 5. **Scratchings** please make every effort to notify the Trials Secretary of scratchings as soon as possible.
- 6. **Inspection of cross-country courses** the cross-country courses will be open for inspection on foot only from 14h00 on Thursday 4th December 2014. Competitors are requested not to walk the courses prior to this time. The cross country course and its environs are out of bounds to all competing horse/ponies from the closing date of entries.
- 7. **Responsibility and Liability** SAEF, Inanda Club, Landowners, Trials Officials, and Sponsors will not be held responsible for any injury, damage or loss sustained by owners, competitors or the public at these Horse Trials.
- 8. **Horse Passports** all horses entered in this event must be in possession of a valid Horse Passport, which must be completed in respect of African Horse Sickness and Equine Influenza vaccinations. All vaccinations must be current and have been administered in terms of the manufacturers' instructions. African Horse Sickness inoculations must have been administered by a Vet and the passport endorsed accordingly. Competitors may be fined should there be any omissions or errors. Passports must accompany the horse at all times.
- 9. **Order of Riding** competitors are required to ride strictly in programme order. Variations to this order may only be made by the Technical Delegate and then only for valid reasons. It is the responsibility of competitors to report to the marshal on time and not the responsibility of the marshal to call the riders. Competitors who do not present themselves on time may be eliminated.
- 10. **Substitutions** only horses and/or riders with the necessary QR's to compete in a class will be allowed to substitute in that class.
- 11. **Restriction on number of classes entered** no horse may compete in more than one class. No rider may ride more than two horses in any one class and no more than 3 in the entire show. A rider may only compete in one age category in the show.
- 12. **Veterinary and Medical regulations** the SAEF veterinary regulations will be strictly enforced. Competitors are advised that, at the discretion of SAEF, horses and/or riders may be tested for the presence of prohibited substances.
- 13. **Horse Inspection (Class 10 & 11).** The horse inspection will take place on the morning of Friday 5th December 2014. The exact time and order of inspection will be circulated to all riders whose entries have been accepted for the event.
