GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1 Classes 1 11 will be run under SAEF and ESA Eventing Rules 1st June 2010
- All tack will be checked before the commencement of each test as per Eventing Rules 45.4.2 & 45.7.3, protective headgear, medical cards and body protectors are obligatory for the Cross Country test. Surcingles are strongly recommended.
- 3 Competitors shall wear the correct dress at all times
- 4 Protests lodged must adhere to Appendix GR/B of the SAEF General Regulations and Section 43 of the Eventing Rules.
- 5 The Organising Committee reserves the right to restrict class entries strictly on a first come first served basis.
- All entries will only be accepted if accompanied by a proof of payment, which should clearly state Rider's Name & Invoice Number as reference. NO PAYMENT
- Any requests for a specific riding order MUST be emailed to ljpmort@gmail.com by the closing date of Entries. It is the responsibility of the competitor to make sure their entries have been received.
 - The dressage tests used are from the 2010/2011 Eventing Dressage Tests available on the ESA website www.eventingsa.co.za.
- 8 The Show Holding Body reserves the right to alter or vary the programme in light of prevailing conditions at their discretion, with the approval of the Technical Delegate.
- The Organising Committee, ESA, SAEF, Inanda Club and Sponsors cannot be held liable for any loss, damage, death or injury to people, horses or property whatsoever. All competitors and spectators enter the premises entirely at their own risk.
- Ponies/horses may compete from the 1 August of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 4 years for Eventing 0.80m and below and 5 years for Eventing 0.90m and Eventing 1m classes
- The Cross Country courses will be open for inspection on foot from 09h00 Saturday 31st January. This is regarded as the official starting time of the event so all
- Eventing rules (including restrictions with regard to dress and saddlery) will be enforced. At the event venue and after the official opening of the courses for inspection, and the duration of the event, it is forbidden under penalty of disqualification for anyone other than the competitor who will ride the horse in the competition, to school a horse.
- 12 As from 26th January no competitor/competing horse may ride in the vicinity of the cross country obstacles, until called upon to do so under penalty of elimination.
- 13 Numbers are to be collected before the Dressage Test and are to be worn for all 3 Tests. Bridle numbers are permitted.
- 14 Competitors please note that Medical cards are compulsory and must be clearly visible on the rider, preferably on the arm. NEW ice id bracelets have been approved by ESA and FEI, for more information go to www.iceid.co.za.
- Sponsors, owners, riders, horses and ponies must be registered with SAEF and ESA for the 2014/15 subscription year as at the closing date of entry. Entries out of order at closing date will be forfeited.
- 16 Horse Box Parking through Maple Road gate and all other show access through the west gate (Saddlebrook entrance).
- A complete list of SAEF General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations, Eventing Rules and Eventing Dressage Tests can be found on the SAEA website www.horsesport.org.za.
- 18 All stallions must have a yellow disc on both sides of the bridle or have a yellow ribbon in the tail.
- 19 EQUINE FLU VACS MUST BE ADMINISTERED WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF THE DATE OF THE EVENT. AHS VACCINATIONS MUST BE UP TO DATE. PASSPORTS MUST BE AVALIABLE
- 20 Dogs must be on Leads
- 21 PORTABLE AND TAPED PADDOCKS ARE NOT ALLOWED (SPACE AND MESS ISSUES)
