

DUTIES OF THE EVENT STEWARD

Explanatory Note: Will replace the “Ground Jury” in the 2010 Eventing Rules. This name change is necessary, due to the new Ground Jury Panel, whose duties are the same as the FEI GJ. These duties are a combination of BE Steward, ESA GJ (2010) and FEI Eventing Steward.

Envisaged as the starting point for people wanting to become Event Officials (Assistant Candidate National Steward). Once they have gained experience assisting the Event Steward and TD’s, and after assessment by the Provinces Eventing Officials Portfolio, would be promoted to Candidate National Event Steward. At this stage could become an Assistant Candidate National TD, or put up for a Level 1 FEI Eventing Steward’s Course, to become a Level 1 FEI Eventing Steward (PMT)

- 1 The Event Steward will be a member of the Candidate National or National Event Steward Panel.
- 2 The Event Steward will assume responsibility for ensuring that the ESA and SAEF Rules are followed, and that the welfare of the horse is held paramount.
- 3 The Event Steward shall, in all classes at an Event not being judged by a Ground Jury:
 - a) Walk the Cross Country courses, and reach agreement with the TD and CD with all aspects in terms of the judging of the various obstacles
 - b) Scoring and recording throughout all of the tests.
 - c) The Event Steward shall be responsible for the supervision of the Fence Judges, Time Keepers, Scorers and Recorders.
 - d) Determination of the final placings, and be responsible with the Show Organiser, for the prize-giving.
 - e) Adjudicate on objections and disciplinary matters with the assistance of the relevant TD.
