CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The FédérationEquestreInternationale (FEI) expects all those involved in International Equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health, before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the Event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper Veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- 5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be run under the new FEI RULES FOR EVENTING (as applicable), the EVENTING SA rules UPDATED 1 March 2015

However we have approval from Eventing SA to run under the OLD Officials rule, but ALL the other new rules applies. It is your responsibility as a rider to familiarize yourself with these new rules!

The cross country course is out of bounds to all competitors and horses.

- 1. We regret that no horse may enter the show without a horse flu vaccination and AHS please complete details on entry form. Passports will be checked when numbers are collected, no passport no show
- 2. NO refunds will be made in respect of cancellations and scratching after closing date of entries.
- 3. Please Note the Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine, vary, divide or cancel classes if insufficient entries are received.
- 4. The Organisers reserve the right to limit the entries to a first come first serve basis.
- 5. Insofar as possible the program and conditions relating thereto will be adhered to. However the Technical Delegate reserves the right to make alterations in the event of unfavorable weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances and should the show be cancelled or postponed for any reason only entry fees will be refunded.
- 6. SAEF, the ESA or the SDRC, the organizers and any officials appointed by these shall in no way be held responsible for any damage, loss, injury sustained by owners, competitors, members of the public or any other person or persons or their property at the Stellenbosch District Riding Club for the duration of the show.
- 7. Surcingles and breastplates are strongly recommended for the X- country phase.
- 8. Approved correct Dressage and Show jumping dress and hats are essential. Gloves are compulsory for dressage
- 9. Skull caps, body protectors and medical aid cards are COMPULSORY at all levels, as per Eventing rule 45.4.2 for X- country phase.
- 10. Plastic Number Vests will be <u>compulsory</u> for Cross Country Phase, Bridle numbers for the Dressage and Show Jumping phases are permitted.
- 11. CATERING: Catering will be available

VACCINATIONS: ALL HORSES MUST HAVE UP TO DATE AFRICAN HORSE SICKNESS AND FLU VACCINATION AND TRAVEL WITH PASSPORTS. NO PASSPORT WHEN COLLECTING NUMBERS - NO SHOW!
