In order to progress to the next Standard, above that for which they are qualified, RIDERS and HORSES/PONIES are required to achieve the prescribed number of Qualifying Results (QRs) as per the Table below.

A QR for Eventing 90 and Eventing 100 is completion of the event without incurring jumping penalties in the Cross Country Test.

A QR for CIC/CNC& CCN/CCI (Long and Short format) competitions is completion of an event with not more that 75 penalties in the Dressage test; plus 0 penalties at obstacles and not exceeding the optimum time by more than 90 seconds in the Cross Country test; plus not more that 16 penalties at obstacles in the Show Jumping Test.
