Windsong Farm

Situated midway between PE and East London, offers 26 hectares of pristine bushveld, forestry and a dam. Cross country tracks are built on permanent grass/sandy soil offering good going all year around.

The natural dam in the centre of the property offers the opportunity to school your horses through standing water. The surrounding area offers the option of a 5km trail though bushveld and farmland.

36 shaded horse camps are available at R100 each as well as 5 stables at R200 each (all for both nights), reserved on a first come first served basis. Thereafter bring own camp facility. Please provide own fodder. Limited overflow stabling is available nearby, thereafter Bathurst Showgrounds will provide stabling.

Self-catering accommodation is available nearby. Alternatively, camping sites at Windsong are available at R50 per person per night. Please see attached accommodation list.

Food and beverages will be available during the day – Saturday and Sunday, please support our caterers!

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead as we are on a nature reserve

This indemnity will be held valid for all riding centre activities from this date onwards.

General Rules and Regulations

1. No refunds will be made in respect of cancellations and scratching after closing date of entries
2. No horse may enter the event without up-to-date horse flu and AHS vaccinations. Equine Flu Vaccinations must be administered within 6 Months of the date of the event.
3. Passports must accompany horses
4. Approved dress code for dressage and showjumping is compulsory. Hard hats, body protectors, sleeved shirts (long or short), overgirths and medical cards must be worn. Body protectors are available for hire at R30 per round plus R100 refundable deposit; payable to the secretary on the day
5. All new competitors to Windsong are required to sign an indemnity form; to save time please email with entry form
6. SAEF, ESA, the organisers and any officials appointed by these shall in no way be held responsible for any damage, loss, or injury sustained by owners, competitors, members of the public or any other person or persons or their property at Windsong Event Centre for the duration of the event
7. The proposed programme with approximate times will be emailed once entries have been received
8. Late entries will be accepted at a 50% surcharge, time permitting. No late entries permitted for SANESA.
9. Insofar as possible the programme will be adhered to, however, the Technical Delegate reserves the right to make alterations in the event of unfavourable weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances. Depending on entries, classes may be combined.
10. All classes will be run under SAEF and ESA Eventing Rules as 1st June 2010, updated 1 March 2015 and FEI Eventing rules as at 8 January 2015. A complete list of SAEF General Regulations, Veterinary regulations, Eventing Rules and Eventing Dressage Tests can be found on the ESA website www.eventingsa.co.za
11. Horses and ponies must be 5 years (4 years for 40cm class) and older.

Directions to Windsong

From Port Elizabeth, continue 20km from Port Alfred in East London direction on the R72. 3kms past Kleinemonde take sharp left hand turn off tar to dirt, signposted 'Shaw Park' Road (opposite the turn off to the Fish River Lighthouse). Pegasus is now also clearly signposted here. Continue on gravel for 2kms, pass Pegasus Equestrian centre on your left. Immediately after Pegasus fencing take 1st left into dirt driveway, keeping fencing on your left. Parking areas for cars and horse boxes will be demarcated.

From East London, 6kms after Fish River Sun, look for the right turn from tar to gravel signed 'Shaw Park' Road. (Follow sign towards Pegasus).

Turn right and follow as above for Windsong Farm.
