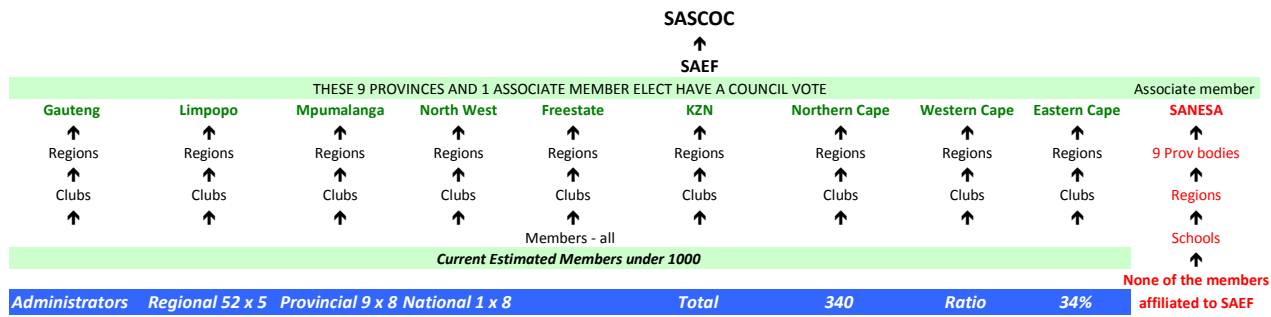


Structure currently being forced upon the equestrian sport in South Africa



What is wrong with the structure above.

These provincial structures are duplicated and play no active roll in the sport

SANESA, whose active members are not members of SAEF, yet have a vote on SAEF council.

DA's (Discipline Associations), who's members were all members of SAEF, have **no** vote on the SAEF council

Who funds the provincial structures?

SANESA is a duplication of the whole equestrian sport, with payments being made to a company owned by the SANESA president, as well as manipulation and disregard for the National Discipline rules.

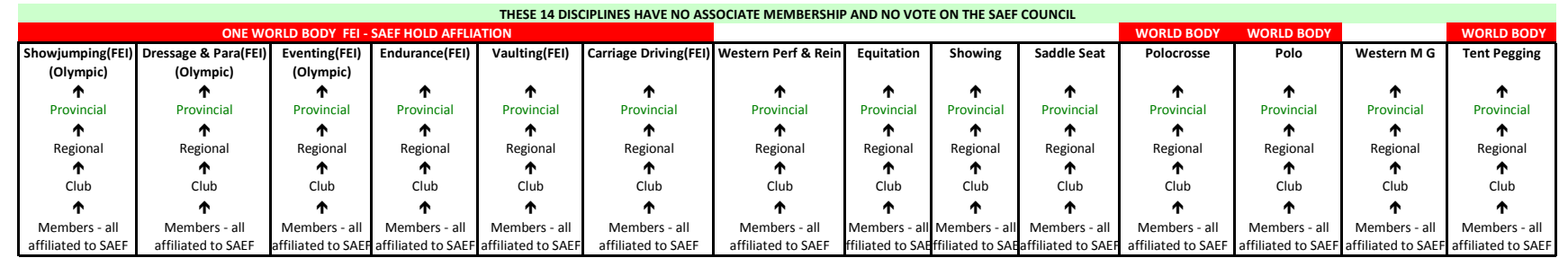
The members of the DA's financially support the SAEF and the sport as a whole, unlike SANESA, yet they have no vote.

DA's already have a provincial body in place, therefore there is no need for the other provincial structures.

Provincial structures cannot possibly have the knowledge and interest of all 14 Discipline associations at hand.

Small DA's will have be lost in current structure

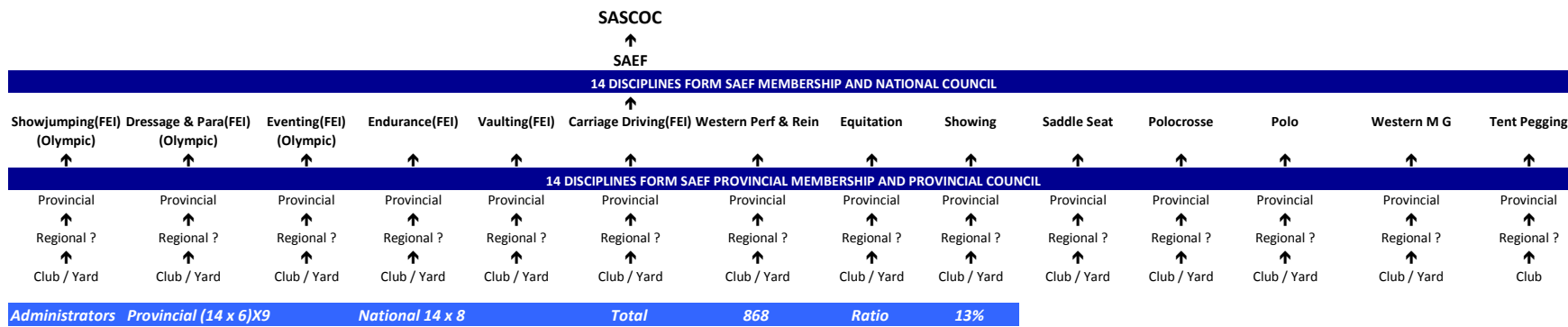
SANESA members are duplicating roles in SANESA as well as regional and provincial structures, hence the attempted takeover of equestrian sport in SA.

Most logical and workable structure for equestrian sport in South Africa



14 Disciplines are separate legal entities with **membership** of SAEF, having representation and vote on the SAEF Council.

Each discipline is self run, as per above structure, under the umbrella body SAEF, who in turn, liases with SASCOC.

Each discipline runs a school league under the National Discipline rules and regulations. School league fees adjusted accordingly. There is no financial gain by an individual person.

There is NO duplication of provincial bodies.

ALL members of ALL disciplines are affiliated to SAEF, ensuring financial sustainability.

All members of SAEF will have a voice on the SAEF council via their club and DA, who has their best interest in mind.

Smaller disciplines will not be lost in the system, as they will have a vote at the SAEF council.
