#### **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

This event will be run under SAEF and ESA Eventing Rules as of 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010, updated 1<sup>st</sup> March 2015 and FEI Eventing rules as at 8<sup>th</sup> January 2015.

However we have approval from Eventing SA to run under the OLD Officials rules, but all the other new rules apply. It is the riders responsibility to familiarize yourself with these new rules. These rules are available on the Eventing SA (<u>www.eventingsa.co.za</u>) and WP Eventing Websites (<u>www.wpeventing.co.za</u>)

### The cross country course is out of bounds to all competitors and horses as of the 17<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2015.

- 1. NO entries will be accepted without payment.
- 2. Equine Flu Vac. & AHS Vaccination must be in order.
- 3. NO refunds will be made in respect of cancellations and scratching after closing date of entries.
- 4. Please Note the Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine, vary, divide or cancel classes if insufficient entries are received.
- 5. Insofar as possible the program and conditions relating thereto will be adhered to. However the Technical Delegate reserves the right to make alterations in the event of unfavourable weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances and should the show be cancelled or postponed for any reason, please refer to Rule 41.4.0 Cancellation Fee.
- 6. SAEF, ESA & FEI northe GRC, the organizers and any officials appointed by these shall in no way be held responsible for any damage, loss, injury sustained by owners, competitors, members of the public or any other person or persons or their property at the George Riding Club for the duration of the show.
- 7. All Classes will run according to current ESA rules. All relevant rules apply.(Website: www.eventingsa.co.za)
- 8. Horses and Ponies must be 5 years (4 years for .80cm Classes & below ) and over.
- 9. By entering a stallion at the GRC, the competitor & owner agree to the following conditions & agree to abide by the following protocol:
  - Competition stallions remain the responsibility of the owner & rider at all times & they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the stallion.
  - It is the responsibility of the owner & rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person.
  - The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise & preparation/competition & only in the presence of a responsible handler or rider.
  - > Under NO circumstances shall the covering of mares be allowed to take place at the GRC premises.
- Stallions are to wear a YELLOW RIBBON at all times either bridle or halter.
- 10. Surcingles and breastplates are strongly recommended for the X-Country phase.
- 11. Approved correct Dressage and Show jumping dress and hats are essential. Gloves are compulsory for dressage
- 12. Skull caps, body protectors and medical aid cards are COMPULSORY at all levels, as per Eventing rule 45.4.2 and 45.7.3 for X- country phase.
- 13. DRESSAGE TESTS can be found on ESA Website: www.eventingsa.co.za
- 14. Protests lodged must adhere to Appendix GR/B of the SAEF General Regulations and Section 43 of the Eventing Rules.
- **15.** Registration of Horse/Pony and Rider with SAEF and ESA, and Club membership must be up to date as at 1 August 2014 for all Classes. The Organizing Committee reserves the ridge to restrict class entries strictly on a first come basis.
- **16.** Entries should be done on line on the ESA Website: <u>www.eventingsa.co.za</u> Please use your invoice number as reference number.

THE CROSS COUNTRY COURSE WILL BE OPEN FOR INSPECTION ON FOOT FROM 12H00 ON FRIDAY 2<sup>ND</sup>OCTOBER, 2015. This is regarded as the official starting time of the event so all Eventing Rules (including restrictions with regard to dress and saddlery) will be enforced.

At the event venue and after the official opening of the courses for inspection, and for the duration of the event, it is forbidden under penalty of disqualification for anyone, other than the competitor who will ride the horse in the competition, to school a horse.

As from the 17<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2015 (Closing date of entry), no competitor/competing horse may ride in the vicinity of the cross country obstacles, until called upon to do so under penalty of elimination.

Any horse that has not been officially entered for the event will not be allowed access to the grounds without permission from the Chairman of the Organizing Committee.
