GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- Will be run under relevant SAEF and ESA Eventing Rules Updated as at 1st March 2015
- All tack may be checked before the commencement of each test as per Eventing Rules 45.4.2 & 45.7.3, protective headgear, medical cards and body protectors are obligatory for the Cross Country test. Surcingles are strongly recommended.
- 3 Competitors shall wear the correct dress at all times.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to restrict class entries strictly on a first come first served basis.
- All entries will only be accepted if accompanied by a proof of payment, which should clearly state Rider's Name as reference. NO PAYMENT NO ENTRY. 6
- The dressage tests used are from the 2010/2011 Eventing Dressage Tests available on the ESA website www.eventingsa.com.
- The Show Holding Body reserves the right to alter or vary the programme in light of prevailing conditions at their discretion, with the approval of the Technical Delegate.
- The Organising Committee, ESA, SAEF, Inanda Club, their officials and Sponsors cannot be held liable for any loss, damage, death or injury to people, horses or property 9 whatsoever. All competitors and spectators enter the premises entirely at their own risk.
- 10 Ponies/horses may compete from the 1 August of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 4 years for Eventing 0.80m and below.
- The Cross Country courses will be open for inspection on foot from 12h00 Saturday 6th February. 11
- As from 1st February no competitor/competing horse may ride in the vicinity of the cross country obstacles, until called upon to do so under penalty of elimination.
- Numbers are to be collected before the Dressage Test and are to be worn for all 3 Tests. Bridle numbers are permitted for dressage and showjumping only. 13
- Competitors please note that Medical cards are compulsory and must be clearly visible on the rider, preferably on the arm.
- 15 Parking in designated areas only.
- A complete list of SAEF General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations, Eventing Rules and Eventing Dressage Tests can be found on the SAEF website www.horsesport.org.za.
- All stallions must have a yellow disc on both sides of the bridle or have a yellow ribbon in the tail. 17
- EQUINE FLU VACS MUST BE ADMINISTERED WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF THE DATE OF THE EVENT. AHS VACCINATIONS MUST BE UP TO DATE. PASSPORTS MUST BE 18 **AVALIABLE**
- 19 Dogs must be on Leads at all times.
- PORTABLE AND TAPED PADDOCKS ARE NOT ALLOWED (SPACE, MESS AND DAMAGE ISSUES)
