GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- Will be run under relevant SAEF and ESA Eventing Rules Updated as at 1st March 2015
- All tack may be checked before the commencement of each test as per Eventing Rules 45.4.2 & 45.7.3, protective headgear, medical cards and body protectors are obligatory for the Cross Country test. Surcingles are strongly recommended. 2
- Competitors shall wear the correct dress at all times. 3
- 5 The Organising Committee reserves the right to restrict class entries strictly on a first come first served basis.
- 6 All entries will only be accepted if accompanied by a proof of payment, which should clearly state Rider's Name as reference. NO PAYMENT NO ENTRY,
- The dressage tests used are from the 2010/2011 Eventing Dressage Tests available on the ESA website www.eventingsa.com.
- The Show Holding Body reserves the right to alter or vary the programme in light of prevailing conditions at their discretion, with the approval of the Technical Delegate.

 The Organising Committee, ESA, SAEF, Inanda Club, their officials and Sponsors cannot be held liable for any loss, damage, death or injury to people, horses or property whatsoever. All competitors and spectators enter the premises entirely at their own risk. 9
- Ponies/horses may compete from the 1 August of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 4 years for Eventing 0.80m and below
- 11 The Cross Country courses will be open for inspection on foot from 12h00 Saturday 6th February.
- As from 1st February no competitor/competing horse may ride in the vicinity of the cross country obstacles, until called upon to do so under penalty of elimination.
- Numbers are to be collected before the Dressage Test and are to be worn for all 3 Tests. Bridle numbers are permitted for dressage and showjumping only.
- Competitors please note that Medical cards are compulsory and must be clearly visible on the rider, preferably on the arm. 14
- Parking in designated areas only. 15
- A complete list of SAEF General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations, Eventing Rules and Eventing Dressage Tests can be found on the SAEF website www.horsesport.org.za.
- 17 All stallions must have a yellow disc on both sides of the bridle or have a yellow ribbon in the tail.
- EQUINE FLU VACS MUST BE ADMINISTERED WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF THE DATE OF THE EVENT. AHS VACCINATIONS MUST BE UP TO DATE. PASSPORTS MUST BE AVALIABLE
- PORTABLE AND TAPED PADDOCKS ARE NOT ALLOWED (SPACE, MESS AND DAMAGE ISSUES)
