GEAL RULES – 2016/17

- All Eventing SA and SAEF rules apply.
- Grassroots horse and rider combinations from Gauteng and other provinces are eligible to accumulate points by competing at the listed participating shows throughout the season. If either **horse or rider** has **placed** at any CNC or CIC1* in the last year OR competed in any CNC or CIC2* in the last two years OR ever competed in any CNC or CIC3* they will not be eligible to participate in the league.

- Points will be awarded at each event for first to twelfth places:

1 st – 12 points	7 th – 6 points
2 nd – 11 points	8 th – 5 points
3 rd – 10 points	9 th – 4 points
4 th – 9 points	10 th – 3 points
5 th – 8 points	11 th – 2 points
6 th – 7 points	12 th – 1 point

All qualifying rounds – 1 point

- First time rider and horse combinations will be allowed to backdate points (for shows completed within the season after registering for the league). But established Amateur League competitors will not be allowed to.
- Riders may enter the league on more than one horse. Points will be awarded to horse and rider combinations and are not transferable. Each combination must remain the same throughout the season although a change of rider is acceptable in certain cases, for instance because of injury, but not where the rider is substituted to gain points. If a rider combination has accumulated sufficient points for two different levels (i.e. EV70 and EV80) during the season, the rider can decide which level to enter for the final.
- In the event of a tie in final scores at the Championship event, the horse and rider with the highest placing on the day will be considered above.



7. Adult Horse and rider combinations need to conclude at least three (3) season events at participating venues (listed below), as well as the Championship event at a venue to be decided in May 2017.
8. Junior and Pony Riders need to conclude at least two (2) season events as well as the Championship event.
9. If a rider and horse combination changes levels during the season, participating in the other level may go towards qualifying for the Championship. i.e. If a Adult rider has completed two EV70 and one EV80, he or she may participate in the EV70 championship. Please note, any scores from levels other than the one you finally compete in will be counted as a qualifying round – i.e. no matter where the horse and rider combination was place you will receive 1 point for that round.
10. Participation in the Championship show is compulsory to place in the league. Riders will take the best two scores from any season shows at that level to the final event. The winners in each category will be those with the highest accumulative score from season events including the amateur championship – that is four (three qualifying, plus champs) in the case of adults, and three (two qualifying, plus champs) in the case of JNR/PR.
11. While scoring will be managed and overseen by the committee, it is the rider's responsibility to register for the league, to inform the league committee of their participation in shows and to ensure their results are accurately captured on the league table.
