

## AFRICA NATIONS CUP EVENTING series Expression of intrest

## Mazibuko - Zambia - December 2016

The Fouth and final leg of the "African Nations Cup Eventing 2016" for group 9 countries is to be held at Mazibuko, Zambia on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> of December 2016.

The team competitions will be run at:

- ➤ CIC 1\* level (FEI Africa Cup) and,
- > 80cm (Africa Shield)

South Africa will select and enter a team in the "<u>Africa Shield Competition</u>" at 80cm only. This is due to the Import/Export requirements between RSA and Zambia that prohibits the return of horses to RSA without a three month quarentine in Zimbabwe.

As per agreements in place with Zambian Federation, Zambia Eventing will provide 4 Qualified horses at 80cm for the RSA team.

The FEI urges countries that select teams to ride on "borrowed" horses, to select the most competent riders available as Eventing is a risk sport and more specifically on borrowed horses.

Riders wishing to make themselves available for selection to represent South Africa at the Africa Shield Competiton in Zambia to please submit the attached document to Elisha at ESA.

- 1. Riders are expected to pay their own airfares
- 2. The team will be accompanied by a team Manager.
- 3. Riders will be provided with ESA team equipment for the horses.
- 4. Riders will be expected to purchase their own team clothing for the show.
- 5. The show holding body has indicated that they will assist with providing accommodation for riders.
