RULES

Classes 1 – 15 (All Eventing Classic Classes)

- To be run under rules specifically for Eventing Classics. Showjumping will be scored per Eventing scoring and certain specified fences will be judged per cross country rules.
- Eventing Classic courses will be longer than normal and include fences like: brush jumps, drums, banks, dyke, arrowheads, corners, bounces, water etc. Fences will be used in the classes relevant to the level of difficulty.
- All in an enclosed arena.
- Eventing Classic Rules will apply. New 16.11.2011
- Horse/pony combination will now be able to compete in two Eventing Classic Classes per day.
- Horses/ponies and/or riders need NOT to be registered.

Dress:

- Jodhpurs/breeches, hard hats with at least 3 point harness, Eventing shirts or jackets and ties + boots
