DATE: Dressage is Saturday 11 November and Stadium Eventing is Sunday 12 November, 2017

CLOSING DATE: Monday 6 November 2017. Late entries will be accepted with a R50 surcharge per class if time allows. (Stadium eventing entries will be accepted on the day with the R50 surcharge)

Only entries with proof of payment will be accepted.

ENTRY FEES: Dressage - R250 per class inclusive of all levies.
Stadium Eventing - R 200 per class inclusive of all levies.

PRIZE MONEY: **Dressage** - Recreational classes: Rosettes only, sponsored prizes if available. Graded classes: 40% of entry fees less levies & sponsorship if available
Stadium eventing - Rosettes for all clear rounds

DRESS: Riders must be correctly dressed for all graded classes. Body protectors and medical cards are compulsory for Stadium eventing. (There will be some on site that can be borrowed on the day)

CATERING: Will be available.

STABLING: R100/day for stables. PLEASE NO DOGS ALLOWED

Membership: Minimum registration with SAEF & a Club and DSA (for graded classes)

NOTES: Neither SAEF, DSA, ESA and Pondarosa Ranch or any of their officials or representatives will be held responsible for accidents, injury, damage, loss or illness to horses or persons or personal property arising from any cause whatsoever at the Show.

All SAEF, FEI, DSA, ESA and ground rules will apply. The Organizers reserve the right to cancel, combine or restrict classes should entries so warrant or according to prevailing circumstances.

In the interest of the welfare of the horse, a horse may only enter 2 classes per day.

Stadium eventing rules and guidance

Stadium eventing has proved to be a great gateway discipline to eventing. SANESA has introduced the discipline in other provinces and the hope is that it can be rolled out to Mpumalanga as well. We recognise that this is a new discipline, and provide the following information as guidance for competitors, parents and instructors. Our objective is a fun day out for riders, horses, and spectators. Here is a link to the rules on the SANESA website, these are the rules currently being applied at most events in Gauteng.

Here is an extract from those rules:

The Eventing Classic series was introduced to provide Eventers with showjumping and cross-country experience in and adjacent to a showjumping arena. The use of crosscountry obstacles such as corners, arrowheads and others found on the cross-country course with conventional show jumping obstacles gives a different experience to competitors. Riders are able to introduce themselves and their horses to cross-country problems in a situation where some poles fall down and hence less chance of injury. Unlike the cross-country test in Eventing, all jumping is also visible to the instructor. As the courses are to be encouraging for their standard, the series also provides the opportunity for horses and riders to gain experience of a higher grade.

The following extract is taken from the SANESA entry forms that were used during 2017. This is for guidance and information purposes. Riders are free to choose their starting height.

Extracted from the SANESA site – some of the clauses that are not applicable are excluded. To be read in conjunction with the SANESA General Rules and Regulations as well as the discipline specifics. STADIUM EVENTING AS a Sub discipline of Eventing the Rules as per ESA National Technical Discipline rules, including/excluding the following:

1. There may be no cross entry of horse-rider combination between levels at any one show with the exception of the specific linked classes within each level
2. No horse/pony may be ridden by more than 1 rider.
3. Show Jumping and Cross Country fences must be designed and built according to the ESA Eventing rules.
4. Medical cards will be compulsory. These cards can be printed from the SANESA website and need to be completed and attached by a medical armband to the shoulder or ankle of the rider.
5. Body Protectors are compulsory for SANESA, recommended for this show. Should athletes not own their own body protector, and they want to use one, we will have some available to borrow on the day
6. At least jodphur boots (boots covering the ankle) are compulsory to be worn by the athlete in the cross country phase.
7. In a regular graded event, vest numbers to be worn & hair to be tied up so as not to obscure the riders number, however we will not enforce this for this show.
8. Surcingle are recommended.

This is the general table of distances and dimensions. Depending on the class, jumps may include, ditch, skinny, water, corner etc, but please remember it is our intention to create a welcoming course that riders will complete and enjoy
