

## **Riders Information**

# 2019 SA National Eventing Championships

#### **WATER**

Be considerate with water. No hose pipes allowed. Please bring your own bucket and sponge. Water pressure is low if all taps are all open at the same time. Please close taps at all times.

## Horse Box Parking

In the interests for all horses and riders no horse box parking is allowed in the show stable area or on the gazebo island. There is designated parking on the polo cross field and behind the Temporary stables.

## Horse Paddocks

There is a designated area for building your own paddocks. No paddocks may be built anywhere else such as the stable area or parking.

## Stable Gazebo Island

Please leave this area free for all to enjoy. No tents, horse camps or vehicles.

## General Warm Up Area

The polo cross field including the 2 fenced camps is the designated general warm up area - but please stay away from the country jumps. All other arenas including the dressage arenas are out of bounds until the beginning of the show on Friday morning.

#### Cross Country Course Out of Bounds

Other than the warm up area on the polo cross field as mentioned above, no horse may be on any part of the cross country course or in the vicinity of the club house until your test.

#### Dressage Warm Up Arenas

Those riding tests in the Nedbank and Equus arenas.

Warm up arena is Top sand arena and arena C.

Those riding tests in the grass arenas warm up is in the open grass area alongside the grass dressage area and the jump storage shed.

## Cross Country Warm Up

Pre warm up is in the smaller of the two fenced camps. Ten horses prior to your start you may go through to the larger jumping warm up arena.

#### Dressage Arenas out of bound on Cross County Track

In the interests of safety the three fixed dressage arenas are DEEMED TO BE TAPED and out of bounds on the country tracks. The tracks run around the perimeter of the dressage arenas but you may not step into the arenas – you will be eliminated.

## **Show jumping Course Walk**

## **Shavings**

Extra shavings will be available to purchase from the show office at R120 per bale.

#### Numbers & Contact Details

Riders to collect their numbers from the office on presentation of passports. NB passports are required to be presented before numbers will be given out. At this time please complete the form detailing contact details of person in case of accident. As per rule 4.1.1 The telephone number of an accompanying person/next of kin must be provided to the Event secretary upon arrival.

## **Grooms Meals**

As there are so many catering options available there are no specific grooms meals. You will easily be able to feed your grooms from the Club Kitchen or other food suppliers.

## **Gate Closed**

The road to the stables and to the club house will be closed on Saterday for the cross country from 8h30 until country is finished.

## **Country Practice**

Riders will be allowed to practice country jumps in the back field only on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup>. The back field refers to the area on the polo-cross side of the road. No jumping can be done on the club house side of the road as this will interfere with show jumping. Those wanting to go out must register with the office on Saturday between 16h00 and 17h00 to sign an indemnity and collect a blue bib. Time slots will be given only while the medic is on the premises.

The levy is R250 per horse plus a R50 deposit on the bib. Riders must be in minimum groups of three with an instructor and all safety requirements must be followed.

Only riders who have registered and wearing a bib are allowed on the course. Please return your bib to the show office and collect deposit before 16h00 on Sunday.
