## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All classes will be run under SASA Showing- Edition 20 effective 1 July 2019
2. The Organizers reserve the right to cancel and combine classes. Classes may be limited or divided at the organizers discretion.
3. In the event of the show being cancelled, 20% will be deducted off of refunds for admin levy
4. All Competitors (Riders, Owners & horses) in Graded Open and Novice classes have to be registered with a recognized club, SAEF & SASA, or must pay a Temporary membership of R90 with their entry fees. Temporary members will not earn Grading or Victor Ludorum Points. Membership forms may be obtained on the SASA website [www.showingsa.co.za](http://www.showingsa.co.za) or from [admin@showingsa.co.za](mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za).
5. SAEF day Membership fee R150. Once a rider has done more than two shows, then the rider must register online and become a full SAEF member
6. No membership required to enter the SASA Riding Horse classes , unless earning points for National Victor Ludorums.
7. No membership required for Newcomers, Young Child classes, or In Hand classes.
8. SASA will pay entry fees for SASA EDTS competitors in all classes. That includes In Hand and Under Saddle classes. The competitor must be an EDTS member of SASA. Membership is free. EDTS application forms, Rules and Conditions are available at [www.showingsa.co.za](http://www.showingsa.co.za) or from [admin@showingsa.co.za](mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za). EDTS members will earn EDTS Victor Ludorum points.
9. Registered SASA instructors will earn National Instructors Victor Ludorum points.
10. Passports, which include a valid height certificate, must be available for inspection on request.
11. All persons participating at this event do so at their own risk and will have no claim against The Royal Riding Club The Royal Agricultural Society, SASA, SAEF, including any officials, employees, members, affiliated bodies, show-holding bodies or sponsors, for any damage or loss of property or death or injury of persons suffered during or in connection with this event from any cause whatsoever. No minor may participate in this event without the permission of his/her guardian, who indemnifies all mentioned above against any such claims by such minors.
12. CRUELTY: Section 02 of the General Regulations and section 95 of the Veterinary Regulations will apply
13. Objections to be made in writing and accompanied by R750 deposit
14. All stallions to display a yellow disk
15. Late entries will be accepted at an additional R100. Entries must include proof of payment. The onus is on the competitor to check entries have been received.
16. No cross entries between Newcomers, Fox Hunter, Open and Novice working hunters. No cross entry between Newcomers, Open and Novice Working Riding classes. However an Open Working riding Horse may enter Newcomers or Novice Working Hunter, and vice versa. No cross entries between Newcomers, Open and Novice showing (Hack, Show Pony, Show Riding, Show Hunter)
17. Parking behind the equestrian club house, enter through main gates
18. **Tiny Tots classes are available for riders under 4 years of age. This is a lead rein class**

## STADIUM EVENTING

19. Riders that entered for Royal are permitted to ride there round( that were previously paid for), but the ground levy and the paramedic levy would have to be paid for
20. No Adult/Junior is allowed to warm up a child's Pony on the day of the show. Anyone doing so will result in the child being eliminated.
21. Competitors can wear any suitable clothing, jackets not required. Safety regulations must be adhered to.
