Promotion of Officials

A schematic for the routes to qualification for Eventing Officials is given as Appendix EV/K on page 78 of the Rules.

The requirements for Technical Delegate (TD) and Event Judge (EJ) are as follows.

Provincial Event Judge (EJ)

- Examination on the Rules
- Course
- Practical Assessments
- Approval by Provincial panel

Provincial Technical Delegate (TD)

- Approved Provincial EJ
- Course
- Practical Assessments
- Approval by Provincial panel

National Technical Delegate (TD)

- Approved Provincial TD
- Course
- Practical Assessments
- Approval by National panel

National Event Judge

Either

- Approved National TD

Or

- Approved Provincial EJ
- Course
- Practical Assessments
- Approval by National panel

The onus is on the Official wanting promotion to get together the required documentation and submit it.

A logbook, signed by a more senior Official, showing shows worked at and in what capacity must be kept and submitted to support the application for promotion.

Assessments for Provincial TD must include at least one assessment by a National TD from a different Province. The candidate for promotion must be aware that he/she is being assessed.

TDs for promotion to National must have worked out of their Province and have assessments from National TDs from different Provinces.

The "Panel" as envisaged in the Rules is:

- Provincial Level. The Provincial Eventing Council, who will use their knowledge and assess the documentation.
- National Level. A "Panel" of senior TDs chaired by the National Officials Portfolio Holder.

Documents should be submitted to:

- Provincial Level. Provincial Officials Portfolio Holder or direct to Council
- National Level. Officials Portfolio Holder
