An Opportunity after the Lay off to practise your Cross Country riding – but not under pressure.

There will be courses prepared, flagged and decorated for Ev.60, EV.70, EV.80 and EV.90's. These will be primarily on the sanded areas of ICB with any particularly hard places aerated. The courses will all run in a similar direction so riders can mix tracks as they like. Times will be taken on request. No judges (you can only fool yourselves if you have a stop and claim a clear – but it is practise so you can do it again !

Likewise you can have a helper out there or even go in a pair with a more experienced horse/pony.)

But, it is NOT a day for instructing a full lesson as this purely get in the way of other riders and will not be permitted. ICB is open to visiting riders most days and then you can pre-arrange to come and have a detailed XC lesson.

In fact, there will have been an Eventing clinic for beginners and SANESA riders on the Saturday. This clinic will be repeated again quite soon if anyone is interested.

This all about horses and riders and encouraging Eventing. But we are still in high risk COVID times and all COVID precautions will be adhered too.

Pre entrance only, masks, screening and social distancing and no spectators – any helpers, grooms and drivers coming in must also have supplied their names and details prior to coming.

Any people entering the premises should not have been knowingly in contact with COVID positive patients in the last 14 days. Everyone must sanitise and give details at the gate, where they will be screened. Anyone with a temperature of 38.5c or above will be turned back.

The Organising Committee, the Show Holding Body, ESA, SAEF, ICB cannot be held liable for any loss, damage, death or injury to people, horses or property whatsoever. All competitors and spectators enter the premises entirely at their own risk.

Everyone is responsible for following Covid prevention requirements, sanitising regularly and wearing face masks when in the proximity of others.
