SHOW ENTRY PROTECTION PLAN

The SEPP will only be available at designated show (NEC being one of them) at the discretion of ECEA. Applicants must be registered members of ESA. The application for SEP must be submitted and paid for by close of entry date. The cover period will only be from receipt of premium up until the official start of the first class of the event. Cover will not be given should the horse become lame, sick or injured during the event or if the rider falls ill or is injured during the show. ECEA committee members will receive a report or an account from a Dr, vet, farrier or physio as proof that there is a health issue for the rider and or horse and will duly consider the validity of the claim. The Claim form with supporting documents must be submitted within 7 days of the end of the show. ECEA will pay out for a claim within 7 days of receipt of an approved claim. This SEPP as agreed to an undertaken by the Eastern Cape Eventing Association in Port Elizabeth on 27 September 2017. Please contact easterncapeeventing@gmail.com for forms and queries.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in International Equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horse's welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health, before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the Event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper Veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.
6. Athletes, Members, and all Affiliates to Eventing SA must ensure that they have read and understand the social media Policy, which can be found on the ESA website www.eventingsa.co.za under Documents/Eventing Rules.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All classes will be run under SAEF and ESA Eventing Rules as at 1 January 2024, FEI Eventing Rules 26th edition effective 1 January 2024 and in compliance of the SAEF Equestrian Sport Ready Resumption document. Any rider, or their entourage, who breaches these conditions will be disqualified and asked to leave the venue, without recourse.
2. All tack will be checked before the commencement of each test. As per Eventing Rules 538.11 and 523.1, protective headgear, medical cards and body protectors are obligatory for the Cross Country Surcingle's are strongly recommended.
3. Competitors shall always wear the correct dress whilst warming up and in the arena.
4. Protests lodged must adhere to the SAEF General Regulations 08.6.0
5. Registration of Rider with SAEF and ESA, and Club membership must be up to date as at 1 January 2024 for all Classes. The Organising Committee reserves the right to restrict class entries strictly on a first entered and paid basis.
6. Entries should be done online on the ESA Website: www.eventingsa.co.za. Please use the Rider's name & your invoice number as reference. Entry payments must be made to the Show Holding Bodies Bank Account.
7. Any requests for a specific riding order **MUST** be emailed to the SHB. It is the responsibility of the competitor to make sure their entries have been received. The dressage tests are available on the ESA website www.eventingsa.co.za and FEI Tests can be found on both the ESA web site as well as the FEI website www.fei.org, or ESA Website.
8. The Show Holding Body reserves the right to alter or vary the programmed in light of prevailing Conditions, at their discretion, with the approval of the Technical Delegate.
9. The Organising Committee, the Show Holding Body, ESA, SAEF, FEI and the **Navarre Equestrian Centre** cannot be held liable for any loss, damage, death or injury to people, horses, or property whatsoever. All competitors and spectators enter the premises entirely at their own risk.
10. The Cross-Country courses will be open for inspection on foot from 12:00 on the 12th of July 2024. This is regarded as the official starting time of the event so all Eventing rules including restrictions with regard to dress and saddlery will be enforced. At the event venue and after the official opening of the courses for inspection, and for the duration of the event, it is forbidden under penalty of disqualification for anyone, other than the competitor who will ride the horse in the competition, to school a horse. Only the rider allowed on the field of play.
11. **As from the 7th of July 2024, no competitor/competing horse may ride in the vicinity of the cross-country obstacles, until called upon to do so under penalty of elimination.**
12. **Any horse that has not been officially entered for the event will not be allowed access to the grounds without prior permission from the Chairman of the Organising Committee.**
13. **Numbers are to be collected before the Dressage Test and are to be worn for all 3 Tests.** Bridle numbers are permitted for the Dressage and Show Jumping phases.

14. Competitors please note that Medical Cards/other forms of medical tags are compulsory for the Cross – Country phase and medical details **MUST** also be updated on the Eventing SA Website. **Please inform the organising committee &/or the medics when you arrive, if you have had any major accident recently involving concussion. It is the responsibility of the rider, or parent/guardian to give this information to the medics.**
 15. Sponsors, owners, riders, horses and ponies must be registered with SAEF, ESA and the Primary Club of choice in the Riders/Owners Geo-Political area, for the 2024 subscription year as at the closing date of entry. Entries out of order at closing date will be forfeited.
 16. Parking in designated areas only.
 17. **Dogs must be on Leads (there will be a FINE of R50 for unleashed dogs)**
 18. A complete list of SAEF General Regulations, SAEF Equestrian Sport Ready Document, Veterinary Regulations, Eventing Rules and Eventing Dressage Tests can be found on the www.eventingsa.co.za. No dressage test will be supplied so competitors must ensure that they have the correct copies.
 19. All stallions must have a yellow disc on both sides of the bridle or have a yellow ribbon in the tail.
 20. **EQUINE FLU VACS MUST BE ADMINISTERED WITHIN 6 MONTHS + 21 days OF THE DATE OF THE EVENT. No horse may compete in the 7 days after the vaccination. AHS VACCINATIONS MUST BE IN ORDER.**
 21. Should the show be cancelled for any reason only 50% of entry fees will be refunded. No entry fees will be refunded if the show is postponed.
 22. All horses/ponies that are prone to kicking must wear a red ribbon in their tails.
 23. No fires are allowed anywhere on the premises.
 24. While the Navarre Equestrian Centre will endeavour to ensure that the perimeter gates are kept always closed, NEC cannot accept any responsibility for any gates left open by any person. Riders are to ensure that their horses are securely kept at all times.

By entering this event I agree to abide by all SAEF’s Safeguarding regulations, including, but not limited to ensuring my family, friends and/or supporters are also aware of these rules. This includes parents only recording images or recordings of their own child’s participation and results. Any form of harassment or abuse will not be tolerated – this includes verbal, emotional and physical.

By entering the competition venue and participating in this event I understand that my image may be captured accidentally on live streaming, photographs, television coverage and/or other mediums utilized during the competition.
