- Jumping Course (90cm maximum height)
- Cross Country Course (90cm maximum height) going through water jump

• COST: R800.00

CATEGORY C

Saturday, 09th

- Dressage Test
- Mixed course with Show Jumping & straight forward Cross Country Fences (80cm maximum height) on Polocrosse Field

• COST: R600.00
